Suryadatta Group of Institutes, Pune, heartily acknowledged the presence of the fire fighters, police officers and other people for their untiring support.

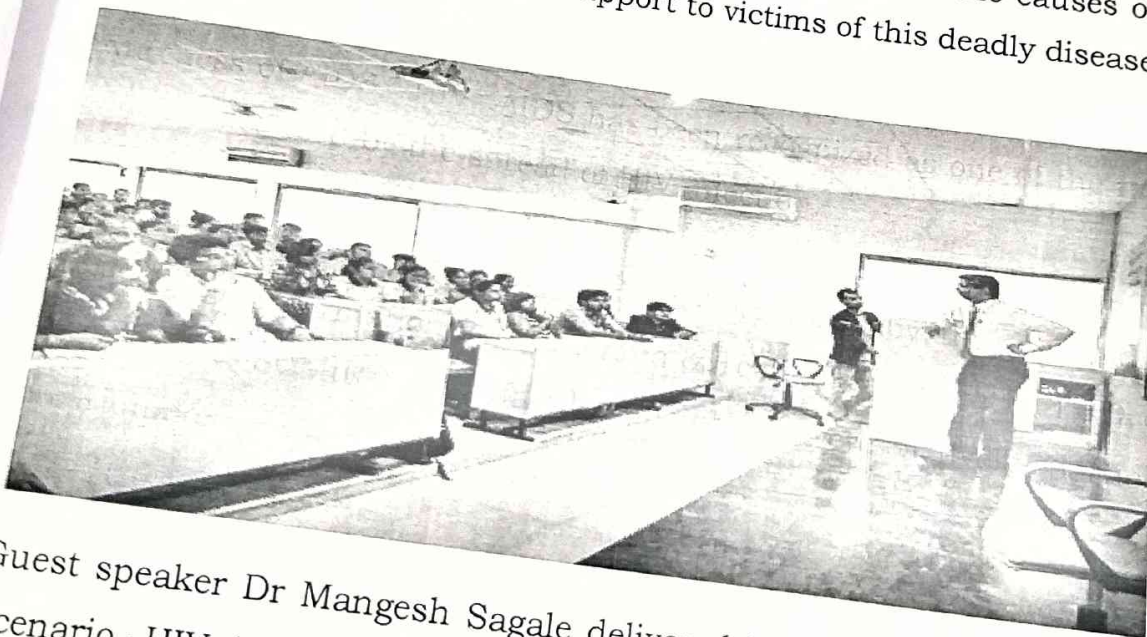
