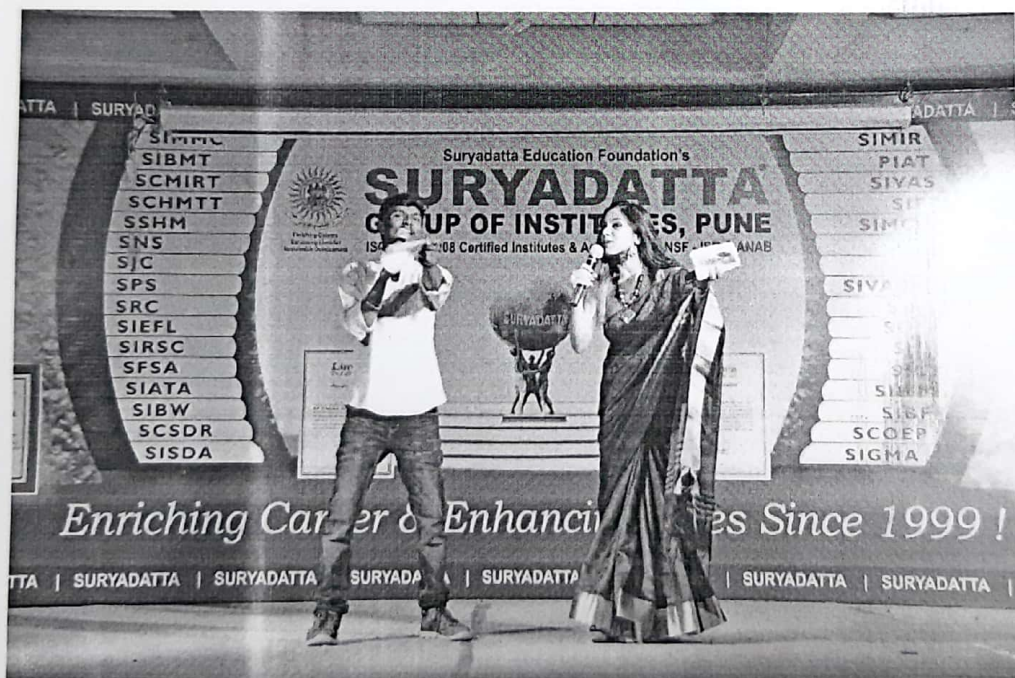

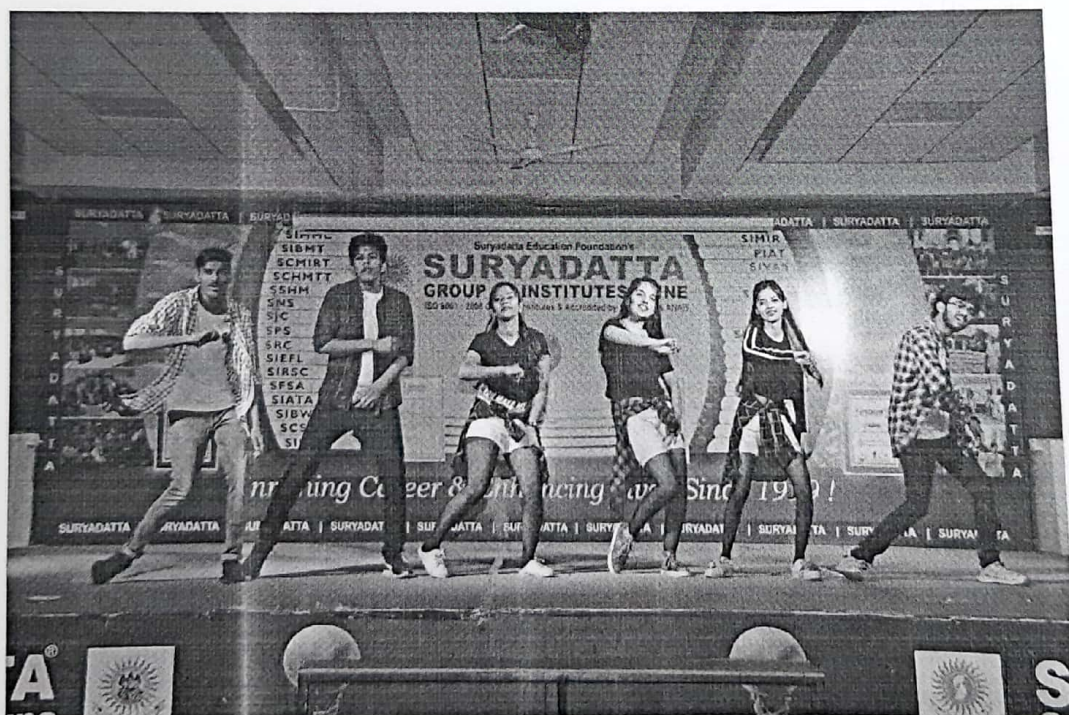

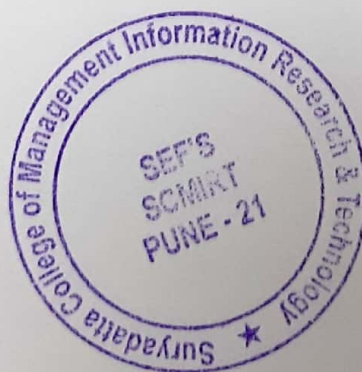

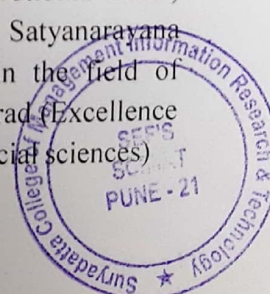
The Students celebrated various days from 1st February 2014 to 6th February 2014.
