18. International Co-operative Day :

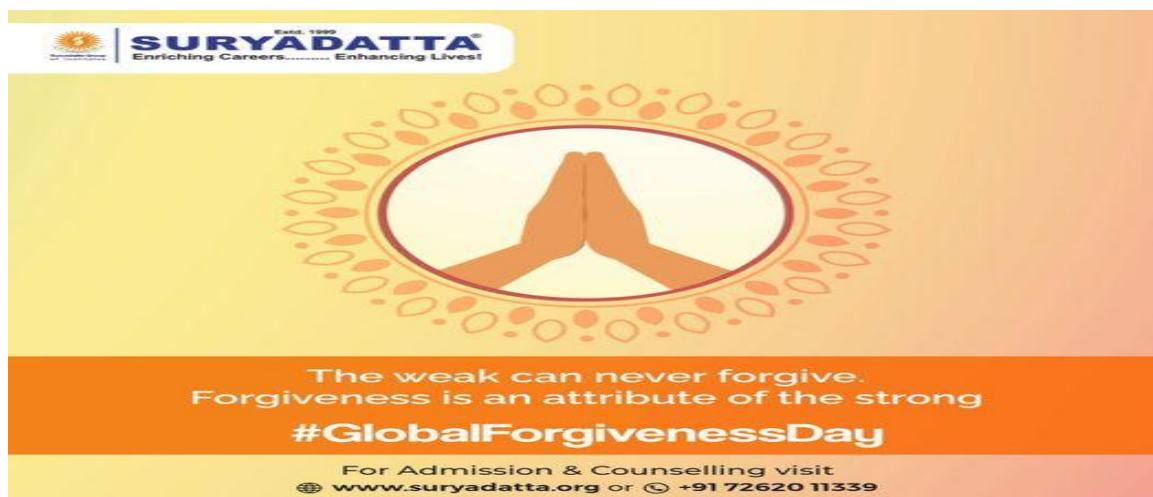

20. Guru Pournima :

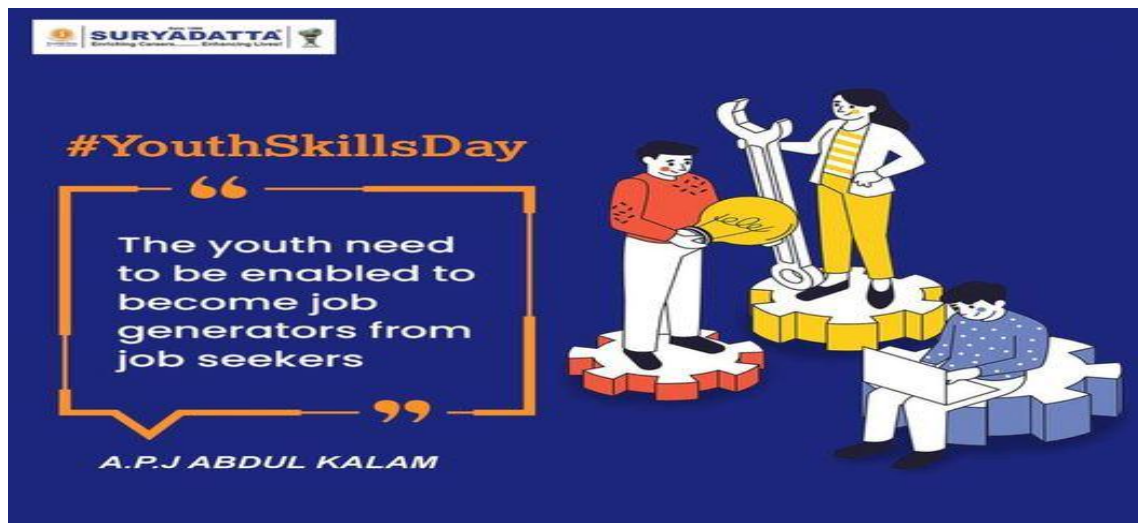

What's the one teaching by your teacher that will always stay with you?



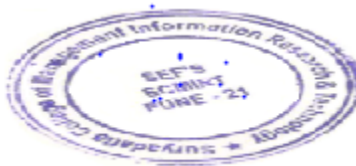

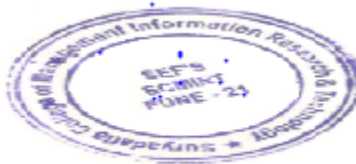
